We gather on the third floor of the student union, eat fantastic meals, and have conversation around how our faith and daily lives intersect. We began holding Food for Thought again during the fall semester 2018 and it has been such a rich, wonderful ministry! After one gathering last fall, a student was helping Sarah clean up and said, "I am so glad we have this. I don't have any other place where I can talk about these things." It was an incredible witness to the work that God is doing in this ministry. This remains our most popular ministry and consistently attracts several of our core students in leadership positions. 
